1 - SPRING CLAMP PLIERS

PARTS LIST:

1. Lift up grey locking tab from Mass Air Flow (MAF) sensor electrical connector.



4. Disconnect turbo air intake hose from MAF using spring clamp pliers.



1 - T30 TORX

1 - 7mm NUT DRIVER OR SCREWDRIVER



 Loosen 7mm hex screw clamp at turbo inlet, then remove plastic air inlet hose.
NOTE: Cover turbo inlet with tape or rag so nothing falls into turbo.



8. Using T30 Torx, unbolt and remove aluminum hot air pipe.



1 - 6" EXTENSION

1 – WD-40 or Equivalent

9. Loosen hose clamps on rubber hose that connects turbo damper to plastic charge air pipe.



10. Using a T30 Torx remove the (2) screws mounting the turbo damper to turbo housing. Pull damper off turbo, then rearward to disconnect from hose.



11. Transfer "O" ring from original damper to *NEUSPEED* Damper, then put a little oil on "O" ring.



12. Install *NEUSPEED* Damper to turbo, using a 10mm socket and supplied (2) M6x25mm bolts install and tighten.



- 13. Using WD-40 or equivalent spray inside of rubber hose, first side on hose as far as possible onto *NEUSPEED* Damper then connect to plastic charge air pipe. Rotate hose to correct position and tighten both clamps.
- 14. Now re-install parts in reverse of disassembly.
- 15. Double check complete installation.

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2. Squeeze grey locking tab, then pull to disconnect from MAF.



3. Disconnect vacuum hose from air filter box lid.



Disconnect hot air duct tube from back side of air filter box.



6. Pull up air filter box to disconnect (3) rubber grommet mounts, then remove.
